The flight operations officer / flight dispatcher competency based training and assessment will need a customer specific LMS set up.

The Recurrent Training Modules are specified in the FOO Recurrent Training Summary and can be scheduled over the 36-month recurrent training interval according to the operator's training requirements and cover the following competencies:

- Air Law
- Flight Performance
- Navigation
- Aircraft General Knowledge and Instrumentation
- Meteorology
- Mass and Balance
- Operational Procedures
- Flight Planning and Monitoring

Following competencies, requiring the specific operator's information are not included:
(but can be implemented as part of the competency based training, if required)

- Contents of the Operations Manual relevant to the operational control of flights;
- Radio equipment in the aircraft used;
- Navigation equipment in the aircraft used, including peculiarities and limitations of that equipment;
- Operational emergency and abnormal procedures;
- Special airports;
- Fuel supply (aircraft and fuel type requirements);
- Communication
