Fire Fighting & Smoke Removal Training

Smoke and fire on board an aircraft create some of the **most critical incidents in aviation**. Flight as well as Cabin Crew members have to perform **initial** as well as **recurrent** fire fighting and smoke removal training.

This course provides the theoretical knowledge acc. EASA regulation PART-ORO required on this topic. As a **completely web-based courseware** it is also targeted to train causes and measures for prevention of smoke and smell development in the cockpit.
