Course Description

A **Flight Operations Officer / Flight Dispatcher** is normally employed to provide supervision of flight and to act as a close link between aircraft in flight and the ground services, and also between the air crew and the operator's ground staff.

Annex 6 – Operation of Aircraft, Part I – International Commercial Air Transport – Aeroplanes, requires that operators demonstrate an adequate organization, method of control and supervision of flight operations, training programme and maintenance arrangements consistent with the nature and extent of the operations specified.

InfoWERK provides initial training for Flight Operations Officers / Flight Dispatchers according **ICAO Doc. 7192 Part D-3** and **IOSA** training requirements. The course is designed for “blended training”, combining web-based training and attendance training. Operator specific information can be added to the course content.
