The specific goals of the course are to:

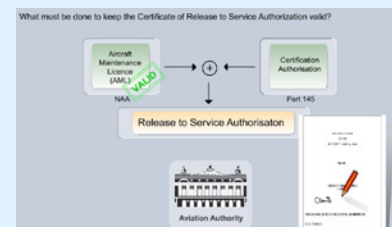
- Build-up the competence of employees regarding the structure and procedures of aviation law.
