Volcanic Ash Avoidance Training

Course Description

Volcanic Ash Avoidance Training is required by EASA regulations as initial as well as recurrent training.

The course has been designed to **familiarize flight crews** as well as **flight dispatchers** with the risks of flight operations with known or forecasted volcanic ash contamination.

The backbone of this course is the **Learning Management System (LMS)** which allows the organization, tracking and documentation of the training activities. Self assessment questions are directly linked to the multimedia-based training allowing the student to check his knowledge and understanding.

Course Content

The **Volcanic Ash Avoidance Training** course covers the following topics:

- General Information on volcanic activities
- Effects of volcanic ash on airports and airplanes
- Indicators of volcanic ash
- Hazards
- Volcanic ash advisory
- Volcanic ash reporting
- Hazard and risk assessment
